

#### Stamp Care & Refill Instructions

See reverse for stamp care



Remove handle from the ChampFast mount by pulling upwards.



Select right color of ChampFast re-fill ink and add the correct amount of drops per list on right.



Put handle back onto mount. Let ink migrate overnight and test stamp.



Slide die box out of ChampFast mount and place it on a piece of paper.



Select right color of ChampFast re-fill ink and add the correct amount into the slotted back per list on the right.



Let ink soak in and slide die box back into mount. Wait 45-60 minutes for ink to migrate then test stamp.

#### IMPORTANT INFORMATION

ChampFast pre-inked stamps are designed to work without the use of a separate ink pad. It is a specialty product that requires proper care to maintain and prolong the life of the stamp. ChampFast stamps utilize an alcohol based ink providing quick dry time on most surfaces. Some surfaces may have special coatings that slow dry time and/or affect the quality of the print. Please Note: Do not overink. Use frequently to prevent the stamp from completely drying out.

#### **STORAGE**

Frequent use is a must with these stamps as they may tend to dry out if not used for long periods of time. Please keep stamp in an upright position and always have the bottom cover in place when not in use. Failure to do so will cause the ink to evaporate quickly. If it becomes necessary to store a stamp for a period of time, add a few drops of ink in each hole prior to storage and a few more once a month to prevent the stamp from completely drying out. Storing your stamp in a ziploc or airtight container will help reduce the rate of evaporation.

# **PROPER CARE**

We recommend adding a few drops of ink when the impression appears to become light. This routine will also increase the life cycle of the stamp. Never allow the stamp to completely dry out as it may be impossible to bring it back to life. Do not overink or you will run the risk of the ink overflowing and creating a mess. When refilling your stamp, give it a little time to soak in. See reverse side for re-inking instructions and the amount of ink to add.

## **USAGE**

For use on porous & most non-porous surfaces including glossy papers, plastic, metal, leather, coated and non coated surfaces and more! Not intended for use on skin.

### **CLEANING**

In case of spillage or a misplaced imprint, it may be impossible to clean a porous surface. For non-porous surfaces, you can try and use 70% or greater isopropyl alcohol.
